We speak to our children regularly about understanding different feelings. We remind them that they must talk to a trusted adult in school immediately if they ever have "big" feelings. "Big" feelings are those that don't go away and stop you from doing normal day-to-day activities.

Last term, we invited the children in years 5 and 6 to apply for jobs that would support the adults and other children around school. These jobs ranged from supporting staff in reception to helping children in our Foundation Stage to read. The Top Team have enjoyed their new responsibilities and they have also learnt new skills. I hope to be handing out more certificates this term to reward the children who have excelled at their jobs!
