SENCO

From next week, Mrs Jackson will no longer be the school's SENCO as she wants to focus her time on teaching. From Ist December, Mrs Sawyer, who works for Waterton Academy Trust, will be employed for one day a week as the school's SENCO. Pupil Premium Funding

Each year, the government gives the academy extra money to support those of our children who are eligible for free school meals. At a recent governors' meeting, the governors reviewed how the money was spent last year. They also looked at whether this group of children had done better in class because of the extra money spent. The governors were pleased that the majority of our pupil premium children reached the expected standard in reading, writing and maths by the time they left Key Stage 2. It was also agreed that we would continue to focus on ways to improve the communication skills of our youngest pupil premium children. Throughout the year, I will be looking at the difference that this extra money is making to the progress of our pupil premium children.
